On Tuesday 19th Aug 2014 I was in plain clothes with PC Anderson 240YE conducting enquiries regarding a Rape that took place on Friday 6th, Saturday 7th and Sunday 8th of JUNE 2014. At around 12.00 o'clock we knocked on the door of a Resident who lives on number [REDACTED] WOODGRANGE GARDENS, ENFIELD who wished not to be named.

The residents (3) are an Elderly couple who have lived at the address for fifty years. They stated that on the Friday, Saturday and Sunday that they were not able to get any sleep due to the "Shouting and Screaming" and thumping music. The Elderly lady mentioned that she is recovering from a stroke, and has too sleep down stairs, and during that weekend felt very vulnerable, due to the level of the noise outside her home.

The Elderly Gentleman, stated that he felt
