


He must not attend a rave, as defined in the criminal justice and public order action organise a rave, supply a property for the use of a rave or enter abandoned proper with written permission.

He must also not enter a private property on an industrial estate between the hou and 7am without permission or engage in any licensable activity in an unlicensed

Police Sergeant Allan Seth, from Enfield's licensing and partnership unit, said: "Co well known for organising illegal raves in Enfield and across London. This order wi way to allowing residents of Enfield and London to live in the peace they deserve.
