

Enfield man given 5yr ASBO

A 34-year-old man who organised illegal raves across London has been given a five-year Anti-Social Behaviour Order (ASBO) at Highbury Corner Magistrates' Court on Tuesday, 4 August. Simon Cordell, 34 (21.01.81) of Burncroft Avenue, Enfield has been given the following prohibitions:

- 1. Attending a rave as defined by s.63 (1) of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994;
- 2. Be concerned in the organisation of a rave as defined by s.63 (1) of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994;
- 3. Knowingly using or supplying property, personal or otherwise, for use in a rave as defined by s.63(1) of the Criminal Justice and Public Order Act 1994;
- 4. Enter or remaining in any disused or abandoned building unless invited to do so in writing by a registered charitable organisation or Local Authority;
- 5. Enter or remaining on non-residential private property on an industrial estate between the hours of 10pm and 7am without written permission from the owner and/or
