No more raving..... party organiser slapped with ASBO

A MAN has been slapped with a five-year ASBO for setting up illegal raves across London.

Simon Cordell, 34, of Burncroft Avenue, Enfield highway, has been banned from going to raves, organising a rave, supplying property for use in a rave.

He is also banned from entering or remaining on non-residential private property on an industrial estate between the hours of 10pm and 7am without the explicit written permission of the owner.

If he breaches any of these orders the raver could face imprisonment.

Police Sergeant Allan Seth, from Enfield's licensing and partnership unit, said: "Cordell is well known for organising illegal raves in Enfield and across London. This order will go a long way to allowing residents of Enfield and London to live in the peace they deserve.

"We urge that should Cordell be seen to breach the above conditions, that they contact Police immediately."


