Mr Cordell called me and was very aggressive and made threats over the telephone. He's saying that we are trying to take his flat away. He also said that Lemmy and I have forged documents, that he's going to get me struck off and will put me in jail. I had to end the conversation. He has tried calling me 6 times after that.

I am putting you on notice that I have contacted the police and reported his phone calls as harassment.

Finally I would refer to the letter before claim/warning letter which was sent to you on Monday 15th October 2018. Mr Cordell has clearly breached the warning. We are now instructed to commence possession proceedings.
