I make this statement in relation to Simon CORDELL and his Anti Social Behaviour Order appeal. During this statement I will attempt to address matters in relation to CAD.

I think it is important to note that I am not CAD trained and therefore have very limited knowledge on the system itself and I have had to seek advice in relation to certain points.

The callers name and number has been redacted from the CAD reports, as I believe this to be normal practice, they are calls from members of the public and residents of the borough who have called to make a complaint with regards to a rave/noise and disruption. It would not be ethical in my opinion to share these details with Mr Simon CORDELL. -One CAD within the bundle is from PC SHINNICK, this is CAD 1047 07JUN14, which is transparent within the evidence bundle.

Where the attendance location is given, I would imagine that the Grid reference is identical for each CAD due to the fact that when the CAD operator types in Progress Way, this is the grid reference that is brought up on the CAD system. This is obviously providing that the callers know that the noise is coming from this location.

I am asked why some of the CAD reports have an earlier time but a later CAD number. For example;

CAD 3005 7JUN14 is entered at 0922 and CAD 3037 7JUN14 is entered at 0920. On first looking at these CADs it would appear that they are incorrect. The CADS should run in order and CAD 3005 should clearly have been entered first, but there is an explanation for this.

On page 3 of CAD 3037 it states created in CHS at 0920 and CAD 0933

On page 2 of CAD 3005 it states created in CHS at 0922 and CAD 0927.

I am advised that when a call is made it goes through to the Call Handling System. They take details and then create a CAD if required. Only once the CAD itself is created will it be given a CAD reference. As you will see above although CAD 3037 called first at 0920, the CAD itself wasn't actually created until 0933, therefore giving it a higher CAD number than CAD 3005 which was created at 0927. I am told reasons for slight delays in creating CADS could be a slow operator, a language barrier, the caller rambling, a chatty caller and many more.

When a call is made to Police it can come one of four ways; Alarms (A) this would be an alarm activation, Emergency (E) this would be an emergency call, Radio (R) this would be via radio, Ordinary (O) this would be an ordinary call/non emergency.

I have checked the Grid References on the below; As you will see the calls from members of the public/residents are within very close proximity to Progress Way. I have provided a map of the area to assist
