Allergies, Known infectious, Past medical history, Medication, FAST (Facial weakness, Arm weakness, Speech), Cannulation, Fluid and drug administration.

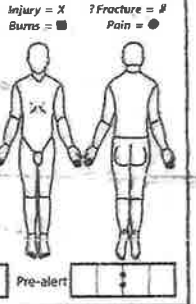
12 Lead ECG: Normal ECG, Inferior MI, Anterior MI, Lateral MI, Posterior MI, LBBB, ST depression, T wave changes only, Other abnormality, Inconclusive ECG.

Airway and Respiratory management: Maintenance, Airway adjunct, ET successful, SGA successful, NCR, Nth.

Cardiac arrest, CPR, Defib, & ROSC: Arrest witnessed, Cause of cardiac arrest, Pre-LAS CPR, LAS CPR, LAS Defib, Pre-LAS Defib, ROSC sustained to hospital.

Table for drug administration: Code, Name, Amount, Dose, Route, Time, By.
